Camp Haluwasa Doctrinal Statement

Being in full agreement with Haluwasa's ministry doctrinal position is very important for every staff member.

Haluwasa's theology could be defined as <u>"evangelical"</u> and a general explanation of our theological position as well as our position on some practical worship matters is provided below.

We consider the Bible to be God's Word and it is our only authority. We believe that individuals can read and understand the Bible with the help of the Holy Spirit and trust it as literal truth. We believe that Jesus is God's only-begotten Son. We believe that we are all born in sin and as a result, we are under the condemnation of eternal punishment and separation from a holy God. We believe that God loves us all and by His grace He has provided a merciful means by which we can obtain complete forgiveness of our sin and establish an eternal fellowship with Him.

We believe that Jesus came to earth to be our example and that He provided a once-and-for-all sacrifice for our sins by His death on the cross. We believe that a person must individually recognize their personal condition of being in sin, having absolutely no merit before God, and having a need for personal salvation. We believe the Bible teaches that when we place our personal belief, faith, and trust in Jesus as our personal Savior, we then become part of God's family, eternally secure with no possibility of future separation from Him. We believe that when we place our trust in Christ as our Savior, our life is immediately transformed by the indwelling of God's Holy Spirit, meaning we now have the power to live a life of faith and grace because God's Spirit is always within us.

We believe that as a result of our life having been redeemed (or purchased) by the blood of Christ on the cross, we become bond-servants of Jesus. As such we are commanded to reach out and share the Gospel message of Salvation with those within our sphere of influence and are challenged to live our life according to biblical principles until the moment when Jesus calls us to meet Him in our eternal home in Heaven.

While there are versions of the Bible we feel do not properly represent Holy Scripture, we recognize several versions including - but not limited to the KJV, NKJV, NIV, NAS, and others. For use in camper memory verses, we often use a trustworthy modern English translation so verses can be more easily understood by young people.

While we do recognize God's "gifts of the Spirit," we <u>DO NOT believe that "speaking in tongues," "healing" and other "sign" gifts are operational today.</u>

We believe that God wonderfully and immutably creates person as male or female, and that these two distinct, complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God. We believe that God created marriage to be exclusively the union of one man and one woman, and that intimate activity is to occur exclusively within that union. We believe dating/courting is only to be between one man and one woman and follow God's perfect plan outlined in the Bible.
